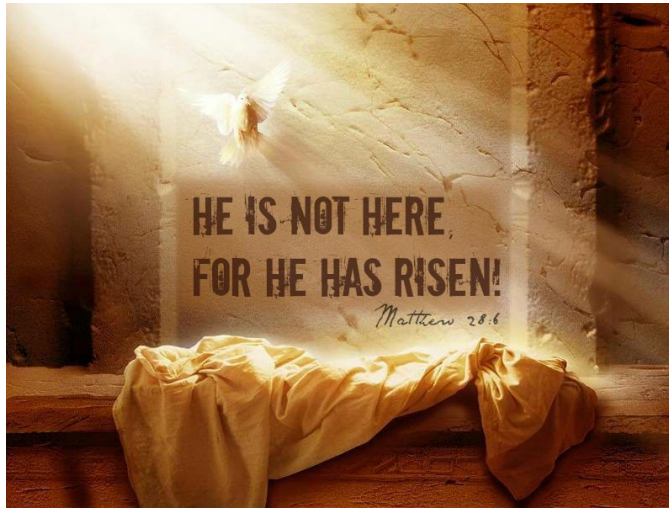

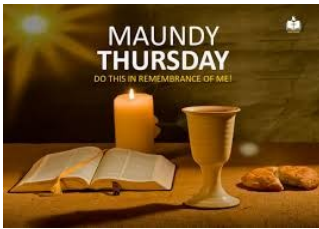

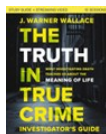

Stay tuned for more details, including ways you can get involved. We would truly appreciate your help—whether through volunteering your time or supporting us with donations.

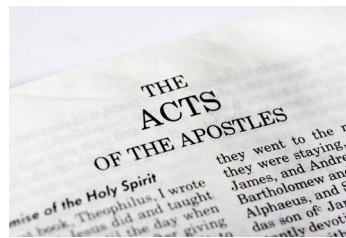

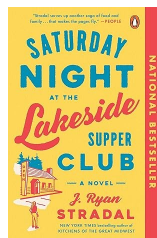

Saturday Night at the Lakeside Supper Club
by J. Ryan Stradal
